## What is SIDS? (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome)

- SIDS is the leading cause of death in infants ages one month to one year in the US.
- SIDS is often referred to the "diagnosis of exclusion" and used as a label for infant death that is not attributed to illness or other obvious causes.
- SIDS can occur in any sleep environment.
- Unsafe sleep is a risk factor for SIDS.

## What does safe sleep look like?

Baby sleeps alone and only in these approved sleep spaces:









Baby is placed on their back for all sleep times.





Safe sleep spaces do not have anything other than a fitted sheet on the mattress

No crib bumpers, blankets, pillows or objects in sleep space
