

## **Book Page Pumpkin**

## You will need:

Book
Paper & Scissors
Sheet of paper
Glue gun
Embellishments
Twig

## Instructions:

- 1. Fold the piece of paper in half and draw the shape of half a pumpkin (make sure it fits the size of your book).
- 2. Cut out the template.
- 3. Remove the front and back covers of the book. If there are heavier cover pages, remove them, too.
- 4. Place the template against the spine of the book and trace it on the page.
- 5. Cut along the traced line. We found the best results came with cutting 10-15 pages at a time. This will vary depending on the sturdiness of the book pages.
- 6. Remove the excess up to the spine of the book.
- 7. Continue until you have cut through all the book pages.
- 8. Using a hot glue gun, spread glue along the outside spine of the book. Place the twig inside the spine along the glue.
- 9. Glue the first and last pages of the book together along the outside of the spine to create the pumpkin shape.
- 10. Embellish as desired.
